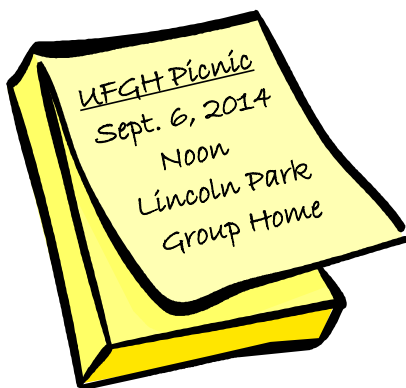

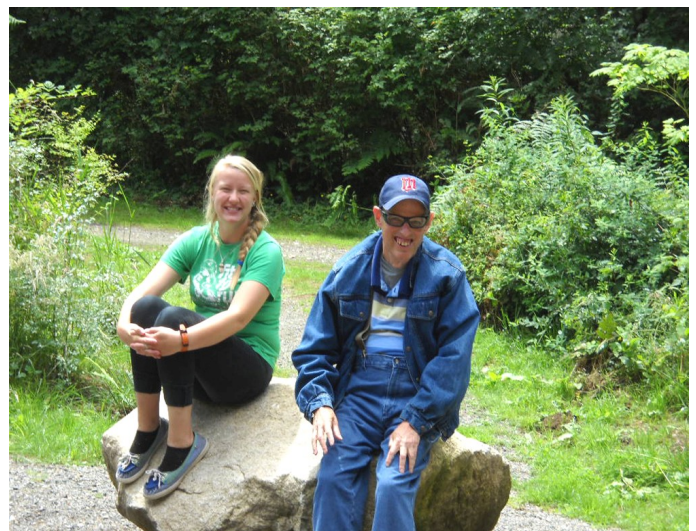

Vashon Island – Earlier this summer

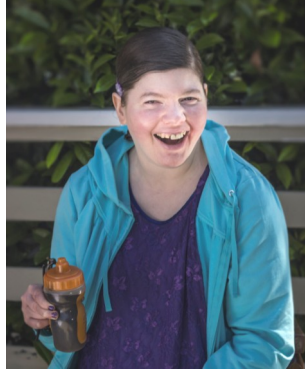
Residents from our three homes embarked on a ferry boat ride to Vashon Island, where they enjoyed beautiful summer scenery - and a picnic lunch!
